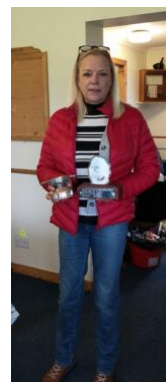


Muthill Ladies Newsletter No 8 2021

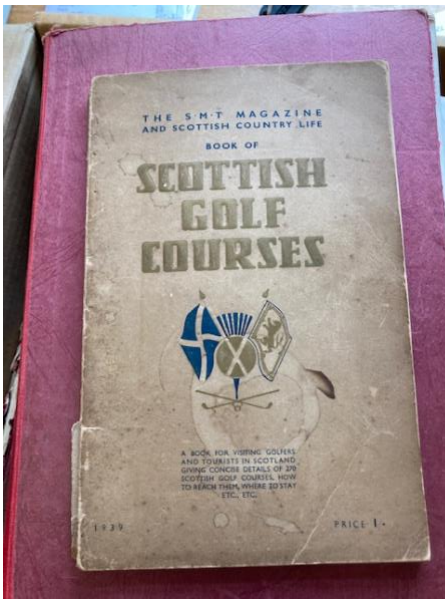

MUTHILL (PERTHSHIRE)

MUTHILL GOLF COURSE (Muthill Golf Club). 9 holes, 2,260 yds. S.S.S. 34. No Sunday play. TEMPORARY MEMBERS—4/- per week, 7/6 per fortnight, 10/- per month. VISITORS—1/- per round. Temporary Members and Visitors are allowed use of club-house, etc. Not licensed. No catering facilities. No caddies.

Muthill (2½ miles) or Crieff (3 miles) Rly. Stns. Club-house ¼ mile from centre of village. ALEXANDER'S buses available at west end of village. The course is undulating and pleasantly situated in Strathearn. Opened in 1935, and kept in very good order.

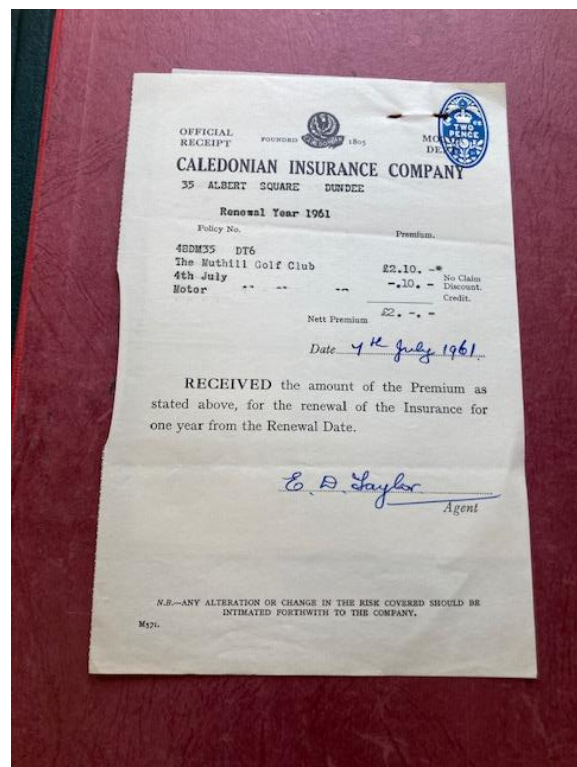
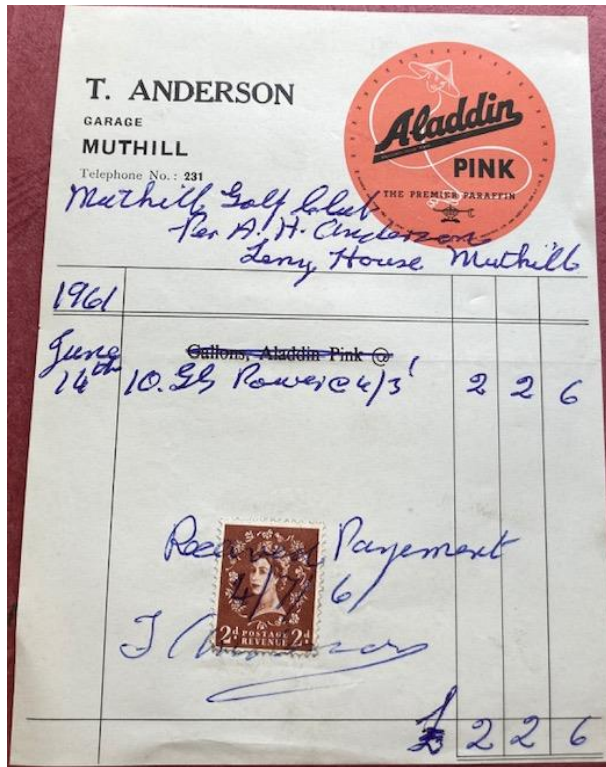
